London-based, Ghana-raised jeweller [Emefa Cole](#) is known for her traditional wax-casting techniques that create layers of gold, silver, rhodium and oxidized bronze. Just last year, the Victoria and Albert Museum added Cole's Vulcan Series ring to its permanent collection, after the piece was noticed at an independent craft fair. Minimal and moody, designs are set with recycled gold as well as vibrant coloured gemstones mined in Africa.
