

When <u>Rihanna</u> stepped out in a silky Zac Posen dress at her annual Clara Lionel Foundation Diamond Ball in 2014, all eyes were on the vast, ruby-red gem suspended from her <u>diamond</u> necklace. The dazzling piece – which features a massive 123.24 carat stone at its centre – is part of Chopard's grand Red Carpet collection. Rih offset the huge pendant (actually a rubellite, even rarer than a ruby), with ruby, tanzanite and rubellite rings, and a rose gold bracelet.
